Dear Parents,

I have had a few questions about the lack of communication when it was announced Greene County moved to RED as our weekly color-code. Because our internal COVID absences have not increased significantly we did not need to make any instructional schedule changes. Since no changes were made, I did not communicate and I am sorry for any inconvenience that caused. In the future, I will make sure to communicate each time there is a change in the color-code, regardless if we make schedule changes.

For those individuals with children involved in winter athletics, the Greene County schools will follow the ticket allocation as described below:

Greene County Extra-Curricular Events:

- ♣ Each player will be represented by a parent/guardian for injury purposes.
- ♣ Each player will receive two tickets for adult parents/guardians only. No children will be in attendance. Two adults only and must maintain social distance within family units. No additional tickets will be granted.
- ♣ All individuals **MUST** always be masked and maintain social distance between family units.
- ♣ No cheerleaders, bands, or pep block allowed. Participants Only.

A few caveats for LSSC.

- Families with more than one participant on a team **only** receive the two tickets
- Participants include **only** dressed players, managers and paid coaches.
- Because of our gym sizes the following allowable tickets are:

HS Main Gym	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Each participant or family of participants will receive two tickets for adult parents/guardians only.</li></ul>
JH Gym	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 1 ticket for parent/guardian who can authorize medical treatment</li></ul>
ELEM Gym	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 1 ticket for parent/guardian who can authorize medical treatment</li></ul>

I can report that Greene County will operate in RED through **at least** January 27<sup>th</sup> as in order to move up a color we must stay in that new color for at least two consecutive weeks. It is our goal to get all students Pre K through 12 back on campus full time as soon as it is safe to do so. We anticipate this can happen once the holiday surge is behind us.

Once again, I am sorry for any inconvenience my neglect to communicate caused and I will inform you whenever any changes are made in our schedule.
