Dear Parents and Guardians,

While COVID 19 continues to impact the lives of individuals throughout the country we are seeing improvements in the positivity rate in Greene County. For the second week in a row we are designated as ORANGE on the weekly color-code map of Indiana. This will allow us to take the step of bringing ALL students back on campus full time.

Beginning Monday, February 1<sup>st</sup> students in grades Pre K through 12<sup>th</sup> grade will attend school on campus Monday through Friday. This is a significant to the social, emotional and educational well-being of our students. Our pandemic practices of wearing masks, social distancing and staying home when you are ill will continue. In order to provide spacing during high school lunches, students who bring their lunch will eat in the gym as those who purchase their lunch will eat in the auditoria.

We will have a bit more freedom within for attendance at our athletic events, however, we must continue to follow the Greene County Health Department expectations. The bullets below refer to contests held in our main gymnasium.

- Each participant\* will receive one ticket for a parent who can authorize medical care in the case of an injury or health emergency suffered at the game. Each participant will receive up to an additional three tickets for disbursement only if the 25% capacity requirement is not exceeded. If the requirement cannot be met, one ticket per participant will be allowed.
- Each auxiliary participant\*\* will receive two tickets for parents.
- No additional tickets will be granted.
- All individuals MUST always be masked and maintain social distance between family units.
- No pep blocks allowed.

\*Participants include players, managers, bench coaches, and cheerleaders.

\*\*Auxiliary participants include the band and Miner Kadets.

For contests held in our middle school gym participants will receive two tickets for parents. Participants include players, managers, bench coaches, and cheerleaders.

We will continue to monitor the COVID situation in our schools and within our community. We hope this move back to the classroom for all is permanent, if changes are made in our school schedule you will be notified. Thank you once again!
